



## **Livestream - technical requirements**

Our live broadcasts (livestreams) are carried out with Zoom<sup>1</sup>. We do not pass on any participant data to Zoom<sup>1</sup>. The entire registration process and participant management runs via VdS systems.

You will receive an email from us three days before the event date with the access data.

In order to be able to receive our livestream in the best quality, you need a stable internet connection and a livestream-compatible terminal (e.g. PC, laptop, tablet or smartphone).

In order to be able to offer the livestream smoothly, we ask you to test your connection before the start (test access via Zoom<sup>1</sup> [here](#)) to ensure that your technology is working properly (see also e-mail with access data). This will allow you to follow the livestream in a relaxed manner.

You can ask questions to the speakers at any time during the livestream via the chat function.

## **Connection procedure**

You will receive a link with your access data. Click on the link to be redirected to Zoom<sup>1</sup> (your standard browser will open). Now you will be asked to install the Zoom client, which we recommend. This is the same procedure as you may know from "GoToMeeting"<sup>2</sup> or "WebEx"<sup>2</sup>. You do not need administrator rights for this. If it is not possible for you to install the Zoom client, you can also participate via browser without installing the Zoom client.

## System requirements

- Internet connection - wired or wireless (at least 2 Mbps, equivalent to 3G or 4G/LTE).  
We recommend a wired connection.
- Speakers or headphones/headset  
We recommend headphones!
- If possible, please make sure not to watch via a server/VPN connection, as this may cause technical problems.
- If you would like to participate via a tablet or smartphone, we recommend installing the ZOOM Cloud Meetings app of the respective operating system.

## Supported browsers

- All known browsers are supported. However, we do not recommend using Internet Explorer because further development of this browser has been discontinued. Please make sure that you always use the latest version of your browser.

<sup>1</sup> Zoom is very stable in terms of connections and user-friendly to operate. Furthermore, since the massive criticism in spring 2020, Zoom has fundamentally updated its security and privacy settings. The warning issued by the BSI has been obsolete since the introduction of version 5.x (end of May 2020). In the meantime, the Bundestag, the Medical Association or the ARD, among others, also work with Zoom.
